





 - I. will increase imports of US goods, e.g. LNG, aircrafts engines, others;
 - II. face increased scrutiny on its goods and work to clarify rules of origin to address trans-shipment concerns. 26 FEB 2025







LARGE POPULATION, LABOR, AND EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AVAILABILITY

Thanh Hoa Province population of 3.7 million people, 3rd largest in Vietnam, a labor force of 2.3 million people and numerous education institutions (universities, colleges, and vocational schools)

Including adjacent provinces (Nghe An, Thanh Hoa, Ninh Binh, Thai Binh, Nam Dinh, Ha Nam) available population increases to 12.5 million people




ESTABLISHED INDUSTRIAL BASE


